BIODIVERSITY ENHANCEMENT OVERVIEW

The main feature of the TEDC Park will be a viewing platform which will provide educational and learning opportunities: members of the team will educate stakeholders – residents, schools, media and councillors- on key topics such as history of the site, environmental concerns and construction impact mitigation.

Further measures to protect the existing habitat and enhance biodiversity will be undertaken during construction activities:

- badger setts will be protected and catered for
- bat boxes will be installed on trees within the site
- reptile tins will be used during construction works
- log piles created with trunks and branches of felled trees will provide shelter for micro-organisms and invertebrates
- detention ponds planted with reeds will create habitat for invertebrates and small reptiles
